Case Studies to Explore Narrative Care

Case Study 1

92 year-old woman, with indwelling catheter, complaining of pain, family wants converted to SPT, patient wants everyone to leave her alone, nurse doesn't want to change a newly exchanged catheter that was draining

Case Study 2

48 year-old man, irate patient, fired from previous practices (including oncology), chart marked as violent offender, PMH of prostate cancer, erectile dysfunction, noncompliance, SocHx: drug seeker

Case Study 3

Provider consistently runs behind schedule, patients complaining of wait times, nursing complains that provider doesn't respond to messages on time, administration wants to improve access, altercation occurs between provider and staff, provider reprimanded
