	Transgender people can be straight, gay, lesbian or bisexual – just the same as everyone else!










	LONELINESS
Social Isolation: Review	Over 1 million older people say they are always or often feel lonely People with a high degree of loneliness are twice as likely to develop Alzheimer's as people with a low degree of loneliness
	Loneliness can be as harmful for our health as smoking 15 cigarettes a day 9% of older people feel trapped in their own home





INTIMACY AND SEXUAL EXPRESSION







Sexual Expression...

- Minimizes Ioneliness







