



#### Fall 2019 Training Conference Results

- November: Person-Centered Care 2.0
  - 77 attended / 95 registered
- Topics included:
  - Trauma and Resilience: Reconnecting to Sources of Strengths
  - Gen Silent
  - Understanding Trauma's Impact on Mental Health in Later Life
  - Utilizing a Person-Centered Approach to Care: Communication and Understanding Behaviors for Persons Living With Dementia




